- Are we reading the standards set by water control for air/phosphate/phosphorus
- Is our system out putting enough oxygen into size of our lake?
- Is there a plan to get rid of our carp?
- The county \$'s we give them need to be spent on the lake not on salaries, etc. I really wonder if the money Neman Lake gives is spent elsewhere!
- I really think we need to et someone other than WSU to do our water quality assessments. They are too comfortable and I really don't trust them to do their job for our benefit. The are too much in the county's pocket.
- I think the AB & district need to be abolished. Need to follow the other counties and need to be county wide.
- During the October 2015 District AB meeting an increase of 10% taxes for district for a 5 year period. This increase included a 6% raising of taxes for Water Quality reserves. Taxes went from 217,000/yr to 238,000 or \$21,000 to be added to Water Quality reserves over 5 years. The \$65,000 only has a proposed \$25,000 in the 2018 budget.
  - Question: what are the actual Water Quality reserves?
  - o What is the \$40,000 plan
- The 5 year tax increase runs out in 2010 and would return to zero increase in 2021 budget
  - Question: will the 2015 tax increase for Water Quality reserves be removed or discontinued in 2021?
- What is the state's position on invasive species?
  - Is it recognized as a problem?
  - o If infestation occurs how or will it be dealt with?
  - Why isn't there a solution for prevention per the state?
    - Wash stations?
